

Materials:

- Dice
- Small pumpkins or any kind of counters (candy corn, buttons, or pom-poms). Paper pumpkins to print and cut if desired are at the end of the materials.
- A patch for players' pumpkins. Download and print ours or make your own.

How to Play:


- 1. Each player rolls two dice and places that many pumpkins in their patch.
- 2. Roll again and add that many more pumpkins to your patch.
- 3. The first player to reach a target number (like 20) wins!

Variations:

- For younger children: Roll one die at a time and count pumpkins as you add.
- Optional Subtraction: After practicing addition, challenge kids to start with 20 pumpkins and "take away" pumpkins on based on what they roll
- If your child is ready for multiplication, they can also multiply the numbers on the two dice and place that number of pumpkins in their patch
