## **How to Play**

- 1. Use painters tape or sidewalk chalk to set up a large number line from zero to your chosen end number
  - We often start with 10 on our number line, but you can change the total value depending on what works best for you
- 2. Start at zero
- 3. Roll the die. Hop the number of spaces on the number line that you roll on the die
  - Ex: You roll 3 → hop 3 spaces on the number line, stand there
- 4. If multiple players are playing then each player should complete steps 1 and 2
- 5. Repeat step 2, moving from the number you landed on the first time
  - Ex: You were on 3 after step 2, you roll a 4 → start at 3 and hop 4 spaces
- 6. The goal is to reach the final number on your number line first-decide if players must reach that number exactly ahead of time

## **Tips for Playing:**

- Add in more math by asking questions like "How many more do you need to get to \_\_\_?" or "What would be too high of a roll to get you to 10?"
- Modify the game by having players return back to zero after reaching the target number.
