



# Numberline Hop



## How to Play

1. Use painters tape or sidewalk chalk to set up a large number line from zero to your chosen end number
  - We often start with 10 on our number line, but you can change the total value depending on what works best for you
2. Start at zero
3. Roll the die. Hop the number of spaces on the number line that you roll on the die
  - Ex: You roll 3 → hop 3 spaces on the number line, stand there
4. If multiple players are playing then each player should complete steps 1 and 2
5. Repeat step 2, moving from the number you landed on the first time
  - Ex: You were on 3 after step 2, you roll a 4 → start at 3 and hop 4 spaces
6. The goal is to reach the final number on your number line first-- decide if players must reach that number exactly ahead of time

## Tips for Playing:

- Add in more math by asking questions like “How many more do you need to get to \_\_\_?” or “What would be too high of a roll to get you to 10?”
- Modify the game by having players return back to zero after reaching the target number.
